


## How to Post a Message on Craigslist.org

1. Go to <http://www.craigslist.org>.
2. On the right-hand side of the screen, click on the city closest to your site.
3. On the left-hand side of the screen, click on “post to classifieds”
4. Click on “community”
5. Click on “volunteers”
6. Input study information in form:

If you answered “yes” to both of these questions, you may be eligible to take part in a national study of an investigational treatment—chelation therapy and vitamin therapy— for people with heart disease.

What is chelation therapy?

Chelation (pronounced key-LAY-shun) therapy is an investigational therapy using a man-made amino acid, called EDTA. It is added to the blood through a vein. A national research study is now testing whether chelation therapy is safe and effective for treating heart disease.

What are the costs?

Study-related treatments will be provided at no cost. Other medical costs remain your responsibility.
