**VIOLATION:**

1. 40 P.S. §1301.701(e); 2. 40 P.S. §1301.701(a)
2. 63 P.S. §422.41(6) and 49 Pa. Code §§16.31-35

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

1. Respondent holds license number MD-031220-E which expires on December 31, 1996.
2. An Order to Show Cause was filed against Respondent on May 8, 1996.
3. Respondent was served with the Order to Show Cause.
4. On August 31, 1995, Respondent had a professional liability insurance policy in effect with Healthcare Insurance Services (HIS).
5. Respondent was notified to pay the CAT fund emergency surcharge.
6. Respondent and the Commonwealth entered into a "Stipulation of Facts and Proposed Sanction" on November 25, 1996, whereby Respondent admitted to not paying the 1995 CAT fund emergency surcharge in a timely manner.
7. Respondent paid the 1995 CAT Fund emergency surcharge in the amount of \$3,704.00 on May 28, 1996.

**Conclusions of Law:**

1. Respondent had an opportunity to be heard in this matter.
2. Respondent is **guilty** of the above violations and is subject to discipline.

ORDER

AND NOW, this 24<sup>th</sup> day of December 1996, upon consideration of the "Stipulation of Facts and Proposed Sanctions" Respondent is found GUILTY of the above cited violations. It is hereby ORDERED and DIRECTED that Respondent's license, number MD-031220-E, is SUSPENDED for a minimum period of three (3) days, beginning at 12:00 a.m., on February 2, 1997 and ending at 11:59 p.m., February 4, 1997, or until the below ordered fine is paid in full, whichever is longest.

Furthermore, it is hereby ORDERED and DIRECTED that Respondent be fined in the amount of \$74.08, to be paid no later than February 4, 1996.
