This matter was opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners upon the application of David Dornfeld, D.O. for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey. On his application, Dr. Dornfeld disclosed that he had been arrested and convicted in 1985 for possession of marijuana. Dr. Dornfeld appeared before the Credentials Committee of the State Board of Medical Examiners on September 3, 1986. During his appearance, Dr. Dornfeld stated that he had been carrying the marijuana for a friend when it was discovered to be in his possession. He further testified, however, that he had used marijuana in the past, most recently, about four weeks previously. Although Dr. Dornfeld testified that he did not use marijuana during times when he would have been treating patients, his conviction for possession of marijuana and his admitted recent use of

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
the drug raise concern with the Board regarding his fitness to practice on an unrestricted license.

THEREFORE, IT IS ON THIS 24<sup>th</sup> DAY OF September, 1986,

HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, David Dornfeld, D.O., is hereby granted a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey upon the following conditions:


1. He shall be required to undergo random urinalysis four to six times within the 12 month period following the effective date of this Order, and

2. At the end of this 12 month period, applicant shall appear before a Committee of the Board for the purpose of reviewing his fitness to practice medicine and surgery and to determine whether the restrictions herein contained should be continued.
