**ORDER**

This matter having come before the Medical Disciplinary Board of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, and the Medical Disciplinary Board, having made certain Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the Director of the Department; and the Department having complied with all required notices; and the time allowed for filing of a Motion for Rehearing before the Director of the Department having now passed;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAY STEWART, DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION of the DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION of the State of Illinois, do hereby adopt the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation of the Medical Disciplinary Board in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Respondent KERRY M. HEITKOTTER immediately CEASE AND DESIST the unlicensed practice of medicine in the State of Illinois and, specifically, cease advertising or using the title of a "Certified Advanced

Bioset Practitioner” and CEASE AND DESIST holding herself out to the public as being engaged in the diagnosis and treatment of physical and mental ailments and conditions until such time as Respondent has complied with the provisions of the Illinois Medical Practice Act, 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes, Section 60/1 et seq., and the rules and regulations promulgated for the administration of said Act.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent KERRY M. HEITKOTTER pay a Civil Penalty in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation within sixty (60) days after the date of this Order. Said civil penalty shall be paid to the SSC- Accounts Receivable Section- Fines- Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation- 320 W. Washington Street- Room # 344- P.O. Box # 7086- Springfield, Illinois 62791-7086 and shall be made payable to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation.

RESPONDENT KERRY M. HEITKOTTER is further apprised pursuant to the civil penalty payment provisions of the Illinois Medical Practice Act, 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes Section 60/3.5 (c), this Order shall constitute a judgment and may be filed and execution had thereon in the same manner as any judgment from any court of record.

RESPONDENT is further warned that continued violation of Cease and Desist Orders could cause criminal sanctions pursuant to 225 ILCS Section 60/59.
