**CONSENT ORDER**

By letter dated February 23, 2009, the Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") noticed Timothy C. Young, D.C., for an informal conference to inquire into allegations that he may have violated certain laws governing the practice of chiropractic in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

In lieu of proceeding to this informal conference, the Board and Dr. Young, as evidenced by their signatures affixed below, agree to enter into this Consent Order affecting the license of Dr. Young to practice chiropractic in Virginia.

**FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The Board adopts the following findings and conclusions in this matter:

1. Timothy C. Young, D.C. was issued license number 0104-555694 by the Board to practice chiropractic in the Commonwealth of Virginia on November 5, 1999. Said license is currently active and will expire on August 31, 2010, unless renewed or otherwise restricted.
2. Dr. Young violated Section 54.1-2915.A(5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), in that by letter dated November 5, 2007, the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Board of Chiropractic Examiners ("Maryland Board") accepted Dr. Young's permanent surrender of his license to practice chiropractic in Maryland, in lieu of further administrative proceedings on allegations of improper record keeping, and that Dr. Young provided substandard care to a patient, which resulted in his death.

3. During an interview on February 29, 2008, Dr. Young stated to the Board's investigator that he has never practiced chiropractic in Virginia.

**CONSENT**

I, Timothy C. Young, D.C., by affixing my signature hereto, acknowledge that:

1. I have been advised specifically to seek the advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me, except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000.A et seq. of the Code of Virginia;
3. I have the following rights, among others:
  - a. the right to an informal conference before the Board; and
  - b. the right to appear in person or by counsel, or other qualified representative before the agency; and
4. I waive all rights to an informal conference;
5. I admit the truth of the above Findings of Fact; and
6. I consent to the following Order affecting my license to practice chiropractic in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

**ORDER**

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and with the consent of the licensee, it is hereby ORDERED that the Board accepts the SURRENDER of Dr. Young's license to practice chiropractic in the Commonwealth of Virginia for PERMANENT SUSPENSION.

Upon entry of this Consent Order, the license of Timothy C. Young, D.C., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

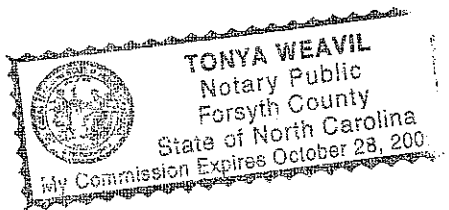
